71 adults came

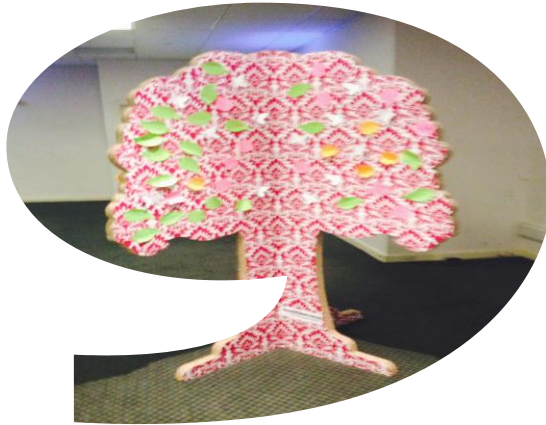


The day was filmed

Young people put ideas on 'Post It' notes and stuck them to the tree

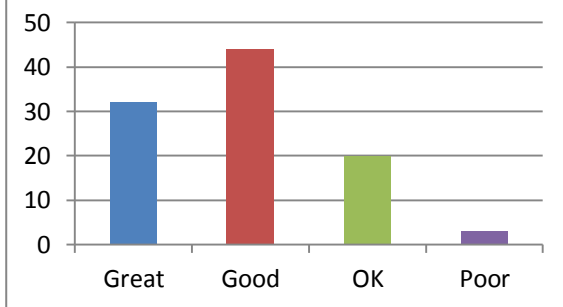


Young people also wrote their ideas on tablecloths

Young people voted on what they thought of the event

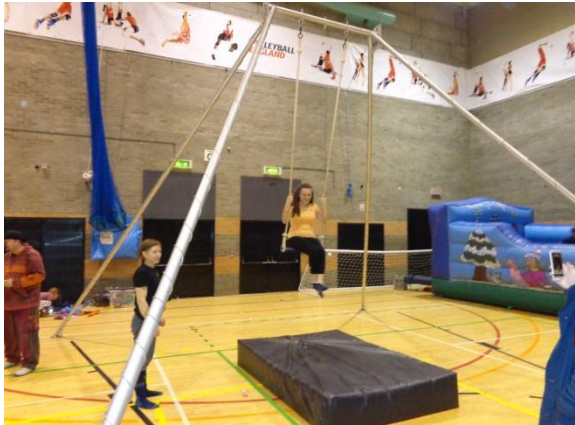
76 per cent voted that they felt the event was great or good
